

and the best quality resin, but due to the nature of the casting process your model may contain very slight air bubbles. These can easily be filled with corrected by immersing the part in hot tap water for about 1 minute then model filler or super glue. Any slight warpage of thin parts can easily be NOTE: We have cast this kit using the most advanced techniques carefully bending it back into shape.
